Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to inform students where to find rules to their sports of interest.

Scope: This policy applies to the participants in the intramural sports program.

Policy: Rules for all sports can be found on IMLeagues under the <u>"Rules & Polices"</u> section. Rules may also be requested by emailing <u>recreation@creighton.edu</u>

Procedure: Rules for all intramural sports are adapted from the National Intramura-Recreational Sports Association (NIRSA), The National Federation of High School Sports (NFHS), the National Collegiate Athletics Associaton (NCAA), and other similar governing bodies. Questions regarding rules and their origin can be sent to the Assistant Director, Competitive Sports.

Accountability/Follow-up: What happens when a student fails to comply or is in violation of the policy/procedure? (e.g. If a student organization does not enter an event into CU Involved, they would be referred to the Office of Community Standards and Wellbeing for failure to comply with the event entry procedure.)

Teams who fail to adhere to the rules of their sport will be penalized as outlined in the respective rule books.
