**Purpose:** The purpose of the intramural pass policy is to inform students of the policies and procedures regardling their individual game schedules.

**Procedure:** Team scheudles are crated by the Competitive Sports Program Staff, and made available via IMLeagues.

# **Policy and Procedure**

#### **TOPIC 7. SCHEDULING**

## Section 1. Regular Season Scheduling

- 1. Team Sports: Teams play on the day and time they select during registration signups. This is done in one, two, or three-hour time blocks.
  - a. Ex: Basketball divisions are separated every hour. A team will play on the same day at the same time, unless a game is rescheduled by the Intramural Office.
    - i. In rare cases, divisions may be split to accommodate less full divisions. Teams may be scheduled for double headers.
  - b. Ex: Flag football divisions are spread over two hours. A team that signs up for a Monday league will always play on Monday. However, they may play at 9 pm or 10 pm, dependent upon the week.
- 2. Individual/Dual Sports: Teams play on the day and time they select during registration signups.
  - a. Some sports will require participants schedule their own games. In these instances, participants will be given the contact email for their opponents.
- 3. Tournaments: Scheduling is based primarily upon the number of entries; thus, teams do not have the option of selecting the day or time which to play. Teams must be prepared to play multiple times per day.

### Section 2. Playoffs Scheduling

- 1. After the regular season, playoff schedules will be posted to the IM Leagues website.
- 2. All teams must be prepared to play on days and times that are different than their regular season games.
- 3. Teams with predetermined conflicts must contact the Intramural Office prior to the end of the regular season to ensure consideration.
  - a. Scheduling conflicts will only be taken into consideration for the first round of playoffs.

#### Section 3. Reschedules

- 1. Due to the large number of teams and limited available facilities, there are limited opportunities to reschedule games. All requests to reschedule a game must first be approved by the Intramural Office.
- 2. Regular Season / Playoffs
  - a. Regular season matches will be not rescheduled.
  - b. Playoff reschedule requests should be submitted to <a href="Recreation@Creighton.edu">Recreation@Creighton.edu</a> by 10:00am the day of the game.
    - i. Reschedule requests after this deadline may not be considered.
  - c. If terms for rescheduling cannot be agreed upon, the contest will be played at the originally scheduled time.
  - d. Once playoff schedules are posted, only games postponed due to weather are guaranteed to be rescheduled.
