**Purpose:** The purpose of the intramural sportsmanship policy is to remind students of personal and team responsibility when conducting themselves during all IM events.

**Scope:** This policy only applies to participants within intramurals.

**Procedure:** At the end of every game, staff who were assigned to work the game will assign teams sportsmanship socres based on their actions on the field/court. Teams are able to see their assigned sportsmanship score immediatley following the game on IMLeagues.

**Accountability/Follow-up:** What happens when a student fails to comply or is in violation of the policy/procedure? (e.g. If a student organization does not enter an event into CU Involved, they would be referred to the Office of Community Standards and Wellbeing for failure to comply with the event entry procedure.)

Teams who reiceve 2 sportsmanship or lower for reasons other than a default or forfeit will be contacted by the AD for Competitive Sports, or their designee. Teams may face suspension or expulsion from the IM program. Teams who repeatedly demonstrate deplorable sportsmanship may be refered to OCSW.
