Uniforms & Artwork

Artwork Approval

All artwork approvals must be submitted via CUInvovled to the SLIC. Sport Clubs are given access to special logos and marks. Questions regarding artwork should be directed toward the Director of the Student Leadership & Involvement Center.

Uniforms

- CSU funds may not be used to purchase uniforms, t-shirts or other apparel for clubs. Sport Clubs are encouraged to use fundraising and club dues to pay for uniforms.
- Creighton University Logos are registered and protected trademarks of the University. No alterations are permitted on the University seal or logo.
- Reproduction of official athletic logos (including, but not limited to: the Bluejay Logo, Bluejay Logo with wordmark "C" Logo, "C" Graphic, "Creighton" Wordmark, and "Bluejays" Wordmark) without the approval of the SLIC Director or their designee.
- All uniforms and t-shirt designs must be approved by the SLIC and Sport Club program following the appropriate guidelines. Designs must be submitted for approval at least 2 weeks before printing date.
- Uniforms must not violate Creighton University's Catholic, Jesuit mission.
