DEPARTMENT/AREA REFLECTION

Consider beginning a regularly scheduled team meeting with the following:

- I. **PRESENCE** Breathe deeply, gently releasing all that clamors for your attention. Become aware of God present with you, within you, surrounding you. Ask for the grace to engage this brief time of reflection in a spirit of gratitude.
- II. **GRATITUDE** Consider your unique contributions to and experiences at Creighton University. For what are you most grateful? As fully as possible, allow appreciation to well without effort.
- III. **REVIEW** Consider your individual gifts and your distinctive role at Creighton. In what ways do you recognize yourself as meaningfully and concretely contributing to our shared mission? Some questions to consider ... select a couple on which to reflect:
 - a. How do the principles of the Jesuit mission align with the values of your department?
 - b. In what ways do you recognize the Jesuit mission influencing the daily work of your department?
 - c. How does your department stand with and for others?
 - d. How does your department care for members of the Creighton community?
 - e. In what ways does your department strive for "the more"?
 - f. How does your department form agents of change?
 - g. How does your department do things for the greater glory of God?
