**Purpose:** To clarify prohibited furnishings in the residence hall rooms.

**Scope:** Pertains to any kind of non-university provided lofts or waterbeds, and applies to all spaces in the residence halls, including personal rooms, shared apartment spaces, and common areas.

**Policy:** Residents may not build or bring in any lofts or lofting beds. University provided beds are loftable. Waterbeds of any kind are not permitted in the residence halls. Beds in the traditional style hall are loft ready, and so can be bunked or lofted.

**Accountability/Follow-up:** Students found bringing lofts or loftable beds or waterbeds into the residence halls will be asked to remove the prohibited furnishings from the residence hall.
