Type: Residential Student Policy	

Purpose: The prohibition on playing sports within the residence halls.

Scope: The terms “sports” as it pertains to this policy includes, but is not limited to, golf, baseball, hockey, soccer, water fights, riding skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, or bicycles, throwing frisbees, ball or other projectiles, and “rough housing.”

Policy: For safety reasons, playing sports in the hallways, common areas, or anywhere else inside the residence halls is prohibited.

Due to potential fire safety concerns, hoverboards are also not allowed inside the residence halls.

Residents may not engage in any sports play inside the residence halls.

Procedure: Residents who observe sports play in the residence halls should report this behavior to the Residential Life staff.

Accountability/Follow-up: Students that are engaging in sports play or rough housing in the residence halls may be subject to disciplinary outcomes. Students will be responsible for any fines or fees resulting from damages caused by sports play or rough housing inside the residence halls. The student’s name and NetID will be documented, and the incident may require further action through the Office of Community Standards and Wellbeing.
